Meekness. *I remain humble while using my strengths and abilities. (Ps. 37: 11; Eph. 4:2)*
I control my thoughts and actions. (Rom. 12:1-2)

Persistence. *I do not give up when the cause is right and worthy. (Gal 6:9, 10; Isa. 40:31)*
I consistently give my best effort in school. (Phil. 4:13)

Initiative. *I do what needs to be done before I am asked to do it. (Prov. 12:24)*
I do what is right whether someone is watching or not. (Col. 3:22-24)

Obedience. *I quickly and cheerfully obey those in authority over me. (Jn 14:23; Phil. 2:14)*
I express my opinions at appropriate times and in appropriate ways. (Prov. 25:11)

Neatness. *I complete my work neatly, on time, and to the best of my ability. (Col. 3:23)*
I keep my desk, my work area, and my room clean and orderly. (1 Cor. 14:40)

Stewardship. *I work to develop my God-given talents and gifts. (2Tim. 1:6)*
